No artwork will be shipped back to the artist. Artists must make arrangements to pick up their work. Work not picked up by July 30<sup>th</sup> will become the property of the Art League of Baytown

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to artists age 18 or older, and to high school students from the following Texas districts: Goose Creek, Barbers Hill, Laporte, Deer Park and Baytown Christian Academy.

Teachers must deliver and pick up all art work of their students.

All artwork to remain the duration of the show

## REGULATIONS

This 3D mask competition is open to any non-perishable medium. Artwork must be original and completed by the artist in the last two years. Artists will submit a written explanation of their process as well as what inspired them and digital images of each piece for publicity purposes. No nudes, nothing political, nor anything violent or controversial is allowed. All entries will be pre-judged for suitability of exhibit.

Size is limited to 18" x 24"; shall weigh no more than 15 lbs. whether displayed on wall, floor or pedestal.

Artists are allowed to furnish their own method of display as long as it does not consume a footprint of more than two feet square. No ceiling displays

All work must be ready for display

## ENTRY FEES and SALES FEES

Artists are allowed 3 entries; 5 entries per high school.

For Art League of Baytown Members: \$15/entry; \$40/3 entries. Sales commission is 15%.

For non-members: \$20/entry; \$50/3 entries. Sales commission is 25%

For High School Students, there is no entry fee; Sales commission is 25%.

**JUROR**, Richard Williams, is an instructor of art at Clear Lake Springs High School and the Alfred C. Glassell Museum School of Art where he has taught for 32 years. He holds an M.F.A. in studio arts and a B.S. in art education from the University of Houston. His philosophy speaks of his passion:

*"If I am not producing art, I am promoting it. If I am not promoting it, I am teaching it; if I am not teaching it, I am learning about it; if I am not learning about it, I am judging it; if I am not judging it, I am producing it."*
